6.5.1 Internal Quality Assurance System

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes. It reviews teaching learning process, structures & methodologies of operations and learning outcomes at periodic intervals and records the incremental improvement in various activities

After the 3rd cycle of NAAC Accreditation IQAC committee reformed according to NAAC Guidelines. It consists management members, principal, Co-Ordinator, Senior teachers non-teaching staff, Students, Alumni, Industry representatives and stakeholders. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the institutions contributes significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance by preparing the Perspective/Strategic plans. The aim of IQAC is Quality initiate, Quality sustenance and Quality improvement. IQAC holds meeting yearly and monitor the regular and other activities in future. In the meeting it gives permission to submit the AQAR reports to NAAC. In the last five years for planning and implementation of various activities to be conducted during each academic year. It efficiently coordinates and monitors teaching, learning and evaluation process.

The IQAC was established in 15th June 2010 to enhance & sustain the quality of higher education. IQAC monitors implementation of vision and mission of college. It prepares perspective plan of Development and executes it in strategic way. It has been trying to institutionalize a number of quality assurance strategies such as:

Strategies for students

- Introduction of Courses: The college has introduced 82 Career oriented courses short term courses, it includes 19 skill-based courses, 32 soft skill,12 ICT and 19 language communication courses.
- Induction Programme: IQAC conducts Induction Programme for first year students. Principal, Vice-Principal, IQAC Coordinator and Heads of the various committees introduce the various activities run by the college.

- 5. IQAC monitors yearly submission of AQAR reports to NAAC in time.

- 6. IQAC prepares code of conduct for teachers, Principal, students, parents and all.
- 7. IQAC encourage the teachers to apply modern teaching aids in teaching.
- 8. IQAC in the year 2020-21 developed PO, CO and PSO attainments mechanism.
- 9. IQAC always encourage to each Departments to start new add on, Certificate and value-based courses.
- 10. IQAC always ask to various departments and research committee to organize National, State level workshop, seminars etc. for students as well as teachers.
- 11. IQAC closely monitors the future requirements of infrastructure and plans accordingly.
- 12. IQAC plans to make Green, Gender, Environmental and Energy Audits for Quality culture.
- 13. IQAC also always motivates the staff to make MoUs, Collaborations, and linkages with various organizations, Industries, and educational institute for students and staff exchange.
- 14. To increase the teaching methods more attractive IQAC plans to buy two interactive boards to make classes smart classroom.
- 15. It always asks to staff to do orientation, refresher and other FDP programmes to increase the knowledge.
- 16. To monitor the teaching of teachers, Teachers Diary initiated and all teachers are asked to fill Self Appraisal forms at the end of the year.
- 17. All the Science Departments are provided with some research facilities and teachers are encouraged to do Ph.D. and other research work.

- IQAC implements e-governances in Administration, Finance and Accounts, Student Admission and Support, and Examination.
