Plan of Action and Objectives

1. Organize State/National Level Conferences/Workshops
 - Encourage departments to propose and organize academic events.
 - Seek collaborations with universities and research organizations.
 - Allocate funds and resources for effective execution.
2. Strengthen Research Facilities
 - Upgrade laboratories and research infrastructure.
 - Provide incentives and grants for faculty and student research projects.
 - Conduct workshops on research methodologies and funding opportunities.
3. Introduce Skill-Based/Value-Added Short-Term Courses
 - Identify emerging fields and design relevant courses.
 - Partner with industry experts for curriculum development and delivery.
 - Promote awareness about these courses among students.
4. Establish a Commerce Laboratory
 - Equip the laboratory with tools for practical commerce and finance applications.
 - Develop modules on accounting software, stock market simulations, and financial analysis.
5. Upgrade Competitive Examination Guidance Center
 - Expand resources, including study materials and expert sessions.
 - Organize mock tests and preparatory workshops.
 - Provide career counseling and individual mentorship.
6. Strengthen Placement Cell
 - Build partnerships with industries for campus placements.
 - Organize training sessions on interview skills and resume writing.
 - Maintain a robust alumni network to enhance job opportunities.
7. Student Adoption Scheme
 - Identify students in need of academic or financial support.
 - Provide mentorship, scholarships, and learning resources.
8. Strengthen Alumni Association Activities
 - Conduct regular alumni meets and networking events.
 - Engage alumni in mentoring current students and funding initiatives.
9. Enhance Sports Facilities
 - Upgrade sports infrastructure, including equipment and grounds.

- Organize inter-college sports competitions.
- Introduce fitness programs for holistic student development.

10. Establish ICT-Enabled Classrooms

- Equip classrooms with smart boards, projectors, and internet connectivity.
